

Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP), 7th Edition

- Successful completion of the NRP course earns the participant an NRP Provider card
- Cards expire every 2 years from issue month/year
- Course does not guarantee proficiency during an actual resuscitation
- eCard may be printed from the Resuscitation Cards tab on your HealthStream account

Prior to the Course:

1. Review the *Textbook of Neonatal Resuscitation, 7th Edition*
2. Access HealthStream using the instructions below and complete 7th Edition NRP Provider Course Part 1.
3. Print your completion certificate for the 7th Edition NRP Provider Course Part 1 and bring it with you for course entry.

HealthStream Online NRP Exam Instructions:

1. You must take the online examination and simulations on any computer prior to your NRP course, during the 90 days before the course.

To access your HealthStream NRP Online Exam:

Click the link www.healthstream.com/hlc/stpetes

Enter the following username and password:

2. To launch the program: Select the “My Learning” tab
Click and open the course
Click and open the first module in the NRP program
 - Exam registration will ask if you have designated an NRP instructor for the in-person components of the NRP Provider Course. The answer is YES. You do not need to name the instructor.
3. Proceed through the online exam
 - Average time to complete exam is 258 minutes
 - You may skip and come back to, or change answers until you click “submit” for grading
 - You may stop after a lesson and come back later
 - Passing score required for each section.
 - Course materials must be completed within the 90 days prior to the in-person course
4. Following the in-person NRP course, you will be graded in HealthStream by the Instructors. You will then need to go back into HealthStream and complete 7th Edition NRP Provider Course Part 2 in order to finish the course and have access to your NRP eCard.
